

# Individual Campout Checklist for Pack Overnighter

A Cub Scout uniform is required for the overnighter. Durable closed toe shoes suitable for hiking are required by Scouts in camp at all times. The following is a list of equipment that would be useful on the campout. Check off each item as you lay out your equipment pack.

## Completed Medical Forms

Scouts cannot be admitted into camp without a completed medical form with the appropriate parent/guardian signature.

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## What to Leave at Home

Firearms, Ammunition, Fireworks, Sheath Knives, Camouflage & Military Uniforms/clothing, Valuables, Radio/Boom Boxes, CD players, Electronic toys, Motorized or Remote Controlled Toys, Personal CB Radios, Aerosol Spray Cans of any type with the exception of insect repellent, Pets
